

SCRIPTURAL CONFESSION:
Wealth Transfer

*I am a good man (or woman); I leave an inheritance to my children's children; and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for me, the justified in Christ Jesus. **Proverbs 13:22, Romans 3:24***

*God is showing me the power of his works, that He may give to me the heritage of the heathen. **Psalms 111:6***

*The LORD will not allow my soul to famish, but He casts away the substance of the wicked. **Proverbs 10:3-4***

*God gives to me the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, in order to confirm that God has called me by His name. **Isaiah 45:3***

Darkness may cover the earth, and gross darkness the people; but the LORD shall rise upon me, and His glory shall be seen upon me. Gentiles shall come to my light, and kings to the brightness of my rising. They will all gather themselves together and come to me. They shall all come, bringing gold and incense, and they shall show forth the praises of the LORD.
