

SCRIPTURAL CONFESSION: Faith and Victory

*Because I believe that Jesus is the Christ (the anointed one), I am born of God. What I do is also born of God. *I continually make the communication of my faith effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in me in Christ Jesus—the anointed One and His anointing. **Philemon 1:6***
